- Ensure compliance with safety regulations and maintain records of all maintenance activities.
- Carry out Duty Manager shifts as required.
- Collaborate with other teams to ensure seamless operations and guest satisfaction.
- Manage inventory and procurement of maintenance supplies and equipment.
- Prepare reports on maintenance activities and provide recommendations for improvements.
- Coordinate with external contractors for specialised repairs and maintenance services as needed.
- Support the Head of Maintenance in managing the maintenance budget, tracking expenses and ensuring adherence to financial targets.
- Respond promptly to guest requests and complaints regarding maintenance issues, ensuring high levels of guest satisfaction.
- Train and develop maintenance team on best practices, safety procedures and equipment usage.
- Maintain accurate records of maintenance activities, work orders and inventory management.
